




1. Fold and unfold both diagonals.




2. Fold and unfold








Blintz Base




1. Valley fold side to side and top to bottom. This is also called Book Foldingand flatten



2. Fold the four corners 3. Finished to the center point


Bird Base




1. Start with a square base.



2. Fold and unfold.






4. Petal fold.








Frog Base



1. Start with a square base. 2. Squash fold.




3. Repeat behind.
